This specification is what we believe to be the minimum you will need to be able to complete the course.

PC Hardware

- Less than 5 years old
- 2GB of RAM
- 1GB of free hard disk space
- SVGA display 800x600
- Mouse / keyboard
- A means of offline storage such as a memory stick or external hard drive
- Internet access - Broadband preferred
- We strongly recommend that students have access to a printer.

PC Software

- Vista, Windows 7 or Windows 8
- either Internet Explorer 10 (or above) or the latest version of Mozilla Firefox
- The latest version of Flash Player and Adobe Acrobat Reader
- Office 2007, Office 2010 (standard edition), Office 2013 or Microsoft 365

Mac Hardware

- Intel based and less than 5 years old
- 2GB of RAM

Mac Software
