PC Hardware

- Less than 5 years old
- 2GB of RAM
- 10GB of free hard disk space
- SVGA display 800x600
- Mouse / keyboard
- A means of offline storage such as a memory stick or external hard drive
- Internet access - Broadband preferred
- We strongly recommend that students have access to a printer.

PC Software

- Windows 7 or Windows 8 or Windows 10
- either Internet Explorer 10 or the latest version of Mozilla Firefox
- The latest versions of Flash Player and Adobe Acrobat Reader
- Any version of Office 2013 or 2016 that includes Access
- A current Anti-virus package that receives periodic updates

Mac Hardware

- Intel based less than 5 years old
- 2GB of RAM
- 10GB of free hard disk space
- SVGA display 800x600
- Mouse / keyboard
- A means of offline storage such as a memory stick or external hard drive
- Internet access - Broadband preferred
- We strongly recommend that students have access to a printer.

Mac Software

- OSX 10.10 El Capitan or newer
- the latest version of Mozilla Firefox
- Office 2013 or Office 2016 (this is regardless of whatever runs natively under the Mac OS)
